RECOMMENDATION

Information Technology Area F Requirements (18 hours)

Eighteen (18) semester hours in lower division (1000- or 2000- level) courses related to Information Technology and/or prerequisite to higher level courses.

<u>Areas</u>	<u>Credit Hours</u>
Programming Courses	6 – 8 hours
Introduction to Information Technology	2 – 3 hours
Mathematics	2 – 4 hours
Finite Math, Discrete Math, Calculus, or Statistics	
Program Specific Electives	3 – 8 hours
Selected from Information Technology, Mathematics, Computer Science, or an IT Application Area	

RATIONALE

The above requirements are consistent with:

- ACM SIGIT's draft accreditation guidelines
- Proposed WebBSIT Area F
- Degrees offered by most USG IT programs

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

AACD will continue to monitor developments in evolving accreditation standards for Information Technology. If modifications are indicated at a later date, we will review and revise these recommendations as necessary.
