 - Fiscal
 - Facilities
 - Others
- Decision by
 - Executive Vice Chancellor
 - Chief Academic Officer
 - Vice Chancellor for Fiscal Affairs
 - Vice Chancellor for Facilities

Academic

- Conformance to Institutional Academic Plan
- Enrollment History and Projections
- Retention Progression and Graduation
- Program Approvals anticipated



Financial

- Sources of Revenue
- Impact on Institutional or PPV Reserves
- Existing Long Term Lease Obligation
- Debt Burden Ratio
- Financial or Operational Issues with Existing Portfolio
- Bond Rating History
- Existing and Proposed Fees



Compliance

- Audit Findings (Past 5 Years)
- Current Open Audit Findings
- Material Weakness in Institution's Financials
- Foundation / LLC Compliance Filings and Reports
- Segregation of Institution and Foundation / LLC



Outcome of Review process

- Proceed to Phase II
 - NOT Project Authorization
- Wait until future
- Do not move forward



Phase II

In Collaboration with Office of Facilities

- Next steps <u>may</u> include
 - Design
 - Appraisals
 - Environmental
 - Housing study
 - Needs assessment
 - Master plan update
- May be sub-phases



Phase II

In Collaboration with Office of Facilities

- May include
 - Consultant Selections
 - Board Project Approval
 - Student Fee Vote
- MAY spend money
 - Institution
 - Foundation / LLC
 - At Risk
