INGRESS Version 4.0 Release Makes a Splash Summer 2014



Four years doesn't appear to be a long time, but in the software industry, four years can seem like an eternity. INGRESS, the USG multi-institution registration system, was initially developed and launched in Fall 2010 with a total of eight institutions. Since 2010, the number of USG institutions implementing INGRESS has grown to 20 schools with over 25 online collaboratives. As the number of institutions offering online collaboratives has grown, so has the need for a robust and scalable multi-institution registration system.

In response to this need, Information Technology Services released INGRESS Version 4.0 on June 13, 2014, culminating an 18-month development process. The latest version of the INGRESS application includes several new features, in addition to enhancements to overall performance.

- New Role Based Campus Administrator accounts have been created, which can be assigned based on functional need and security level. The role based levels of access allow for greater targeting of information established by user needs.
- A new Messages tab (Message Board) has been added to the INGRESS Administrator Console. To streamline the number of messages sent to Campus Administrators, updates have been made to the INGRESS automated messaging system. With the enhanced messaging system, only high priority email notifications are sent to INGRESS Campus Administrators. Lower priority messages are stored on the Message Board on the INGRESS Administrator Console for individual use.
- Institutions designated as the sending course section are able to reserve a pool of seats or allocate all seats in a shared course section to partner campuses. This feature provides increased flexibility in managing course seats across multiple campuses.

Finally, Collaborative Program Services extends a sincere appreciation to Georgia Southern University, the University of West Georgia, and Valdosta State University for participating in the INGRESS 4.0 beta testing sessions.

GoVIEW Goes Mobile

In response to the widespread use of mobile devices for teaching and learning, GoVIEW is now available in a mobile delivery format. GoVIEW Mobile Basic includes the ability for users to log in with a mobile device (provided it is the appropriate device with the minimum supported operating system) and access Desire2Learn's mobile enhanced learning environment. Additionally, a limited number of third party, integrated applications are now available in mobile format. Users may view content, participate in discussions, access library resources, and have limited email capabilities.

The Assignment Grader allows faculty to access Dropbox submissions, markup individual submissions, assign grades, and associate rubrics.

Blackboard Collaborate Mobile provides students and faculty access to most participation tools and capabilities in Collaborate; however, use is not recommended for session moderators.

Turnitin Originality Reports and GradeMark are available in the mobile application for faculty. Smarthinking provides limited mobile tutoring services for students.

Thinking Smart About Online Tutoring

Getting help with Math, Science, and other online courses just became easier for students enrolled in collaborative courses delivered on GoVIEW. Starting with the Spring 2014 term, Smarthinking tutoring services are available to all students enrolled in courses delivered on GoVIEW. The seamless integration of the Smarthinking portal with GoVIEW allows students to access online tutoring services directly from their collaborative course, without a required secondary login. Tutoring is available in a variety of subject areas including nursing and composition.

Blackboard Collaborate Web Conferencing

GoVIEW has a new web conferencing tool to support synchronous teaching and learning activities. Blackboard Collaborate is an additional third party application integrated with GoVIEW/D2L. Other GoVIEW third party resources include Smarthinking online tutoring service, Turnitin plagiarism detection, and Respondus LockDown Browser test delivery security. Blackboard Collaborate will run concurrently with Wimba Classroom in the learning environment through July 31, 2014, after which time, Collaborate will serve as the sole web conferencing tool. Collaboratives are encouraged to use the summer semester to save and migrate the Wimba Classroom archives to a multimedia server. Production support for Wimba Classroom as a third party application in GoVIEW will end August 1, 2014.

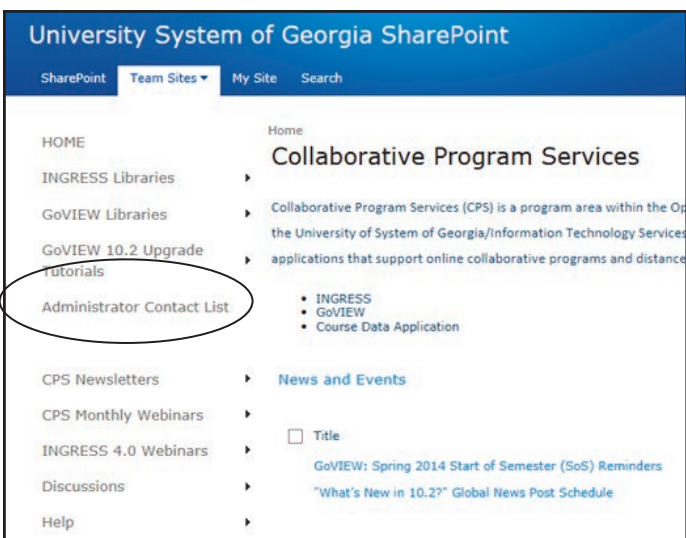
