KI8159: GL – ISSUE WITH PLANT ALLOCATION PROCESS USING PROJECT ID

An issue has been identified with the Plant Allocation process when adding a Project ID field under the Target tab. Please note that this will also apply to any PPV allocation that uses a "prorata with record basis" allocation type.

FUNCTIONAL IMPACT

ITS has discovered an issue when users add a Project ID field under the target tab for an allocation step using a basis. The user will receive the message below and the process will run to no success.
