**SUBJECT:** Vendor Naming Convention and Best Practices Job Aid Available

**PURPOSE:** To notify users at all institutions using Georgia *FIRST* PeopleSoft Financials Version 8.9 that a new job aid providing naming standards and best practices when adding new vendors is now available.

**FUNCTIONAL IMPACT:** The new **Vendor Naming Convention and Best Practices** job aid sets forth vendor naming standards and best practices for maintaining vendors. This document has been reviewed and approved by a Vendor Focus group involved in the Consolidation project and the Accounting Issues Committee.

Institutions should confirm that any users responsible for adding new vendors follow the naming standards provided in this document. These naming standards provide a guideline for consistency and accuracy in the naming conventions for new vendors, and will also assist in reducing the number of duplicate vendors.
