


SwiftView installation on Windows 7


In Internet Explorer, navigate to:




Click on the yellow bar at the top, and chose "install Add-in".




Click "Install"

Once SwiftView viewer is installed you will see a picture of a Swift at the right, using browser-based SwiftView. Then you can run standalone SwiftView Viewer from Start...Programs...SwiftView and test it with sample files downloaded from [here](#).







When the following message box appears, click on "Open"




The file should unzip using your default zip utility.

Double-click on the file “dfs-fs_swiftview”



When the following message box appears, click “Run”




You may get a warning message asking you if you want to continue, if so, click “Yes”.

You will then get a confirmation message saying the changes have been successfully added to the registry.


Set SwiftView to be the default program for LIS files

Right click on an LIS file and choose “**Open With**”. Make sure the checkbox for “**Always use the selected program to open this kind of file**” is checked.



Click “Browse”

This will open the **Program Files** folder (see image below). Open the **SwiftView** folder, and double click on **svview**. This is the executable file for SwiftView. Now, anytime you choose to open a LIS file, it will use SwiftView to open the file.



You may get a confirmation window asking you if you want to make SwiftView (standalone) the default application to open this type of file. If so, click Yes.
