## KI8097: AP 1099 Update Withholding Process (AP\_WTHD\_UPDT) Abending

UPDATE: January 25, 2010

**RESOLVED:** The issue with **1099 Update Withholding** process (AP\_WTHD\_UPDT) abending has been resolved. The updated application engine was put into production on Saturday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>, and the process is now available for you to run. Please note that the process may run slowly, depending on the number of lines that need to be processed.

Note: Only one institution can run the modified process at a time. If a second institution tries to run the process simultaneously, the status in the Process Monitor will show Blocked. You do not need to do anything in this situation. The second process will begin automatically once the first process completes.

**UPDATE:** January 22, 2010

**STATUS:** The **1099 Update Withholding** process (AP\_WTHD\_UPDT) has been corrected, and the updated application engine is scheduled to be put into production tomorrow, Saturday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>. The process will be available for you to run at noon.

Note: Only one institution can run the modified process at a time. If a second institution tries to run the process simultaneously, the status in the Process Monitor will show Blocked. You do not need to do anything in this situation. The second process will begin automatically once the first process completes.

UPDATE: January 20, 2010

**STATUS:** Both OIIT and PeopleSoft continue to investigate what is causing this issue, and identify and implement a resolution as quickly as possible. You will be notified as soon as this issue has been corrected.

As noted below, you can enter your updates on the **Update VoucherLine Withholding** page. **However, please do not run the Update Withholding process until further notice. If you do, it may require a Database Intervention (DBI) to correct the data errors that may be created, further delaying your 1099 process.** 

Until this issue is resolved, please continue your 1099 processing as noted in the 1099

**Process Job Aid 2009** document that was posted on January 7, 2010. Review the other 1099 reports and queries to identify other necessary cleanup as noted in this document. This includes resolving any vendor issues that need to be corrected, and completing any manual adjustments to journal entries and other transactions that need to be corrected.

OIIT is currently looking into what is causing this issue, with the goal of identifying a resolution as quickly as possible. You will be notified as soon as this issue has been corrected.
