



Known Issue: KI9.2-10 PO Issues with Multi-SpeedChart Functionality on Purchase Orders

UPDATED November 6, 2015

STATUS: RESOLVED (As of Release 5.00 November 14th)

IMPACT: A PeopleSoft fix will be applied as part of Release 5.00, which resolves the known issues

surrounding the use of the Multi-SpeedChart functionality on purchase orders. User's can resume using this functionality and will no longer receive an error message after running

PO budget checking.

When attempting to use the Multi SpeedChart functionality on purchase orders, the following issues have been reported:

- PO budget checking runs to No Success; and
- Users receive an error message of "Purchase Order cannot be saved (10200, 732) because budget processor is running in the background" when attempting to make changes to a purchase order.

Functional Workaround:

Users should not attempt to use the Multi SpeedChart functionality until this issue is resolved. You will need to manually enter ChartFields instead of selecting the Multi SpeedCharts link on the distribution page of the PO.

Estimated Resolution:

This is a known Oracle issue and a resolution is tentatively planned for Release 4.50 (November, 2015).
