

GENERAL INFORMATION

Purpose

These Release Notes are to inform PeopleSoft Financials technical staff and functional users of the scheduled 2.32 release of BOR functional application enhancements.

TECHNICAL IMPACT

Database

- The Scheduled downtime for the F89PRD Production database will be from the normal maintenance window beginning at 11:00 pm on Friday, April 20, 2012, until 7:00 am on Sunday, April 22, 2012. The actual maintenance period may be shorter. If that occurs, the F89PRD database will be available sooner. An announcement will be sent to the Financials listservs when the release has been applied, verified, and database is available again.
- NOTE: The system cache may be cleared as part of the release process. ITS recommends that all users clear their temporary internet files when logging back into the system. Please be aware that the initial loading of pages may be slower than normal on the first business day after a release because of this. It is highly recommended that all users clear their browser cache often, especially after an update is applied to the Production Transaction database.

MODIFICATIONS TO EXISTING BOR PROCESSES AND REPORTS

BORBUDSC (Schedule C)

BOR Menus > BOR Budget Prep > Budget Prep Reports > Schedule C

Schedule C (Statement of Revenue) was modified so that negative values in the original budget are now treated as such. Previously, negative values were converted to positive values when part of the original budget. This is consistent with the way that Proposed Budget handles negative values.

New Distrib Tab

The New Distrib tab was modified to correct errors encountered when using Distribution by Amount.

The RET Provider Final Extract file is modified to sum ERS Benefit_Plan 'OAR' rows in a single row.

Prior to modification the ERS Benefit_Plan 'OAR' produced two rows, one containing regular contribution amounts and the second containing the ERSCON pick-up amount.

The RET Provider Final Extract file for TIAA-Cref is modified to address reporting date issues as follows:

- Employment Date should not be greater than Rehire Date
- Plan Entry Date should not be greater than Rehire Date
- Termination Date will not be reported beyond the reporting month
- Rehire Date = Termination Date will not be reported in the reporting month
- Record Type = 23 for Participant Dates

BOR CR RETAC

- Default the Distribute to GL flag ON and grayed out
