



Mirabeau Bonaparte Lamar established the *Columbus Enquirer* as a weekly newspaper in May of 1828, making it the third oldest newspaper in Georgia. The paper began publishing on a daily basis in 1859. In 1874, the *Enquirer* merged with its largest local competitor, the *Columbus Sun*, and became the *Columbus Enquirer-Sun*. The *Columbus Enquirer* Archive spans the years 1828-1890 and includes over 32,000 images.
