





MacAvov Comments Signatures Any discussion of faults in governance has to begin with an explanation of the corporation's ultimate purpose: that is, the criteria by which the corporation's performance and success are to be measured. Throughout its development the corporation has had one stated objective: 'the conduct of business activities with a view toward enhancing corporate profit and shareholder gain'.¹ While some have argued that employees, suppliers and communities deserve at least some of the residual, or 'profit', this has generally been rejected as being in conflict with the conceptual model and state law and judicial decisions. Corporations are not charitable organizations, and neither are they formed to undertake fund disbursal programmes determined by managers. In the abstract, the corporation is a set of contracts for inputs in production, such as land, labour and materials, all financed by owner-provided capital. While contractees have rights to income for services rendered, only owners have rights to profit after all costs have been incurred and the product has been sold. The owner bears the risk of variation in this residual profit and has then the right to disburse it or otherwise withdraw the capital. Effective Use Loading MARC Records



Integrating MARC records into your OPAC

- Single most important step to ensure adoption
- Some libraries have increased usage 300-500%
- OCLC will create collection set -- Free
- Records available for 90 days on FTP server
- Coordination required with library's technical staff

Effective Use Loading MARC Records



- Usage of Amigos Collection increased **100%**, when comparing 3 months before/after loading MARC records
- Usage of collections became more widely distributed across subject areas after loading MARC records
- Anecdotal evidence to show that as students and faculty become more familiar with eBooks, demand will increase

4 million of 8 million titles circulated


Ebook usage rate = 200% / year





Effective Use Patron Access



Remote Access to eBook Collections

- Authentification by:
 - IP Address / Range
 - User name & password
 - Secure referring URL
- Patron can access remotely, if:
 - Library has remote patron authentification system
 - Username/password needed only for remote checkout

Access Patterns

Average Session Length = 23 minutes
 Average Time in a Book = 5-15 minutes

Effective Use Collections Development



Collection size drives usage

- Shared Collections (e.g. SOLINET collections)
- TitleSelect (NetLibrary's online catalog, select individual titles)
- TitleDirect (online profiling and notification service)
- Patron Driven Acquisition
 - Reduces turnaways
 - Guarantees 2 circulations
 - Can limit expenditures with pre-defined spending caps

Effective Use Marketing



Create awareness for Ebooks

- Links from referring sites (e.g GALILEO, Library Website)
- Customizing website with your library's logo
- Book Tool Kit (http://www.netlibraryebooktoolkit.com/promoting)
 - Promotional materials (e.g. posters, bookmarks, pens)
 - Press releases, Ebook events, newsletter articles
- Email to patrons
