


V7 Beta Common Testing Environment Available

There's still time to get access to the Banner V7 Common Testing Environment hosted by OIIT. If you are interested in beta testing V7 but your institution's hardware and required infrastructure isn't ready yet, contact Karen Nunn (karen.nunn@usg.edu) to sign up as a V7 Beta Site and get details about the Common Testing Environment. Note: This environment will not include an interface to a mock PS Financials database and will only be available during the beta testing period.

This pre-production release experience will provide an opportunity to update business process documentation and potentially train staff to accommodate new or changed functionality.

Special Characters in Banner and the Impact on WebCT Vista

Using special characters in the College Code Validation Form (STVCOLL), Course Title field on the Basic Course Information Form (SCACRSE), and course title on the Schedule Form (SSASECT) are problematic for WebCT Vista. When loading these fields in WebCT Vista, an error is created. The error is resolved during the load process by replacing the special character with a space but the problem persists in the fact that it takes much longer to load the file than it should.



These special characters are: $(/, \setminus, :, *, ?, <, >, |, :, ", \&, =, +, $, @, ., ")$. The special characters are UNIX and XML commands and cannot be used during the loading of data into WebCT Vista.

Banner Student System Consolidation Project Gets Underway

The Banner Student System Consolidation (SSC) Project - better known as the Banner Hosting Project - got underway in January 2006. Phase One includes six volunteer campuses - Bainbridge College, South Georgia College, Waycross College, Fort Valley State University, Atlanta Metropolitan College, and Georgia Gwinnett College. The student and financial aid systems for these institutions will be hosted on hardware residing in the OIIT Athens facility where levels two and three technical support will be provided. While each institution will have its own production and test instances, all will be running the same "model" Banner system, based on Banner baseline plus the GaBEST mod set. Business process analyses will be conducted at each institution and potential enhancements may be made to ensure USG students receive the benefits of efficient, consistent operations at each campus utilizing the full potential of the Banner software. The project schedule calls for initial analyses and testing over the summer, training during late summer and early fall 2006, and moving the institutions into production during the fall semester 2006.

Banner Production Support Web Site Updated

The Banner Production Support site (https://www.usg.edu/banner/) provides both technical information and functional documentation about baseline Banner and the Georgia Enhancements directly to technical personnel and functional users at University System of Georgia institutions. Links to technical documents, release information, test plans, user instructions, and functional training materials are included. The site is updated for every release.

Product Calendar



HOPE Scholarship Authorization

When HOPE Scholarship authorizations are made by the student via Self Service, an authorization code is placed on the Authorization Form (TVAAUTH). This code authorizes the institution to use HOPE Scholarship funds to pay outstanding charges other than tuition and mandatory fees. Institutions may have varying results for application of payments and refunding based on the use of the Banner Baseline delivered Return to Title IV Enhancement.
