Question:In what order does Registration Fee Assessment initially assess charges, and what is used to determine the order of charges when the student's account is updated in the Accounts Receivable product?

Answer:NOTE: The answer below is based upon Alphabetic Detail Codes and Category Codes. If you use Numeric Detail Codes or Alpha-Numeric Detail Codes, the sort will be the appropriate Oracle sort based upon the definition of the Detail Code.

Registration Fee Assessment will assess charges using the following method. These results can be queried on the SFAFAUD Registration Fee Assessment Audit History Form.

- a) Section Fees are assessed first, in CRN order, and alphabetic by Detail Code within the CRN
- b) SFARGFE rules are then assessed. Student Type, then Level, Campus and finally Attribute Rule Types are assessed. Within each type, the assessment occurs by SFARGFE Rule Sequence Number from lowest to highest.
- c) Additional Fees from SFAEFEE are assessed last, alphabetic by Detail Code

When the assessment is transferred to Accounts Receivable and TBRACCD (TSAAREV) is updated, the following sort is used:

- a) Alphabetic by Category Code [eg. BIL, FEE, NRF, then finally TUI]
- b) Alphabetic by Detail Code within Category

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
