Question: How are receipt numbers calculated in Accounts Receivable? Answer: The receipt number is generated whenever a detail code that has the Receipt indicator checked on TSADETC is entered on an account. Receipt numbers are also generated by the TSRRFND auto refund process.

Detail codes can be entered on the forms: TSAAREV, TSADETL, TSADETF, TSAADSP, TSASPAY, TSAMASS, TSAMISC, TFAMASS, TFADETL, TFADETF, TFAMISC and TFAADSP.

The actual determination of the receipt number occurs via the tgkb_common1.sql package. The function f_update_sobseqn_receipt within the package calculates the next receipt number. The SOBSEQN table is updated each time a receipt is generated. Banner AR processing looks at this table and issues the one up receipt number as the next receipt number.
