Problem based module assists students with basic math remediation, abbreviations, conversions, dimensional analysis, metric system measurements, and experiences in reading medication labels and using syringes

Case scenario based module focuses students on common issues faced by new graduates in practice such as effective delegation and supervision, patient safety, ethical decision making in practice, and legal aspects of providing nursing care

Case scenario based module assists students with understanding and interpreting basic laboratory measures as they relate to providing safe and effective nursing care (Module currently under development)
