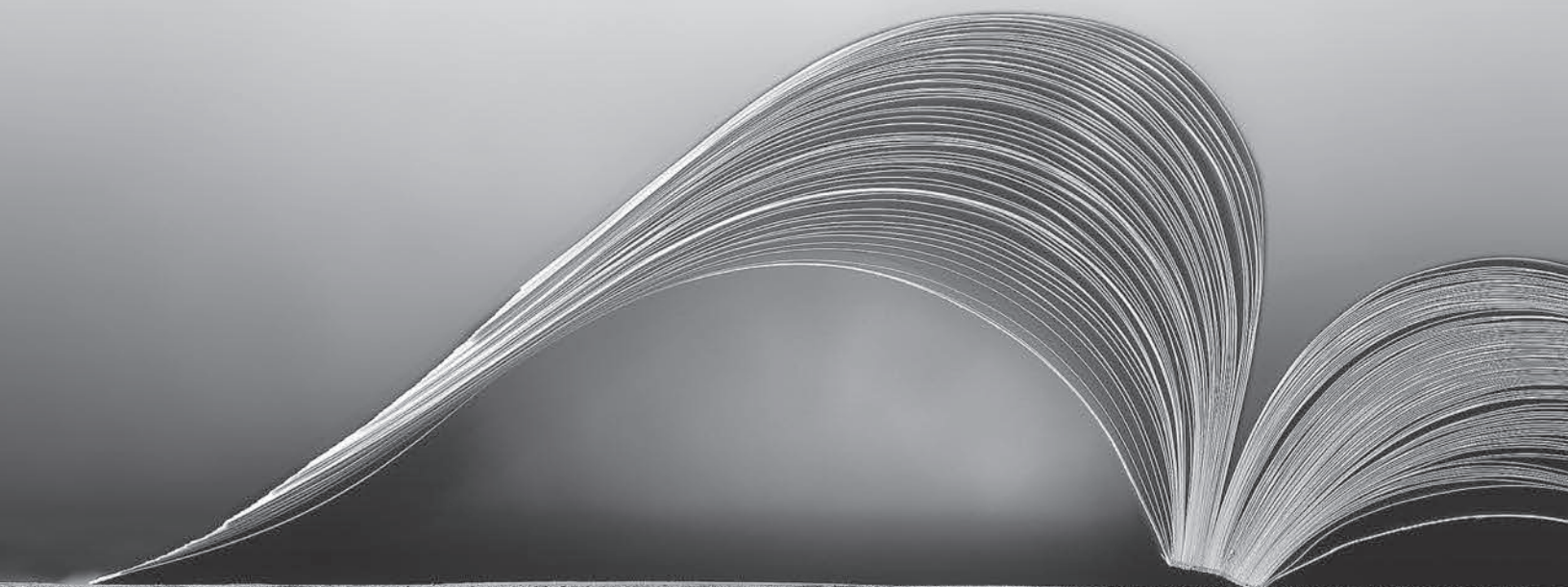


# STUDENTS

- The System enrolled 253,552 students in Fall 2005, and it had an FTE enrollment of 218,617.
- In Fall 2005, 65 percent of students were white, 24 percent African-American or black, 3 percent Hispanic, 6 percent Asian, and 3 percent all other. Fifty-eight percent were female.
- Thirty-three percent of students attended part-time.
- Business and nursing were the most popular undergraduate majors in Fall 2005.
- There were 39,960 first-time freshmen in Fall 2005, up 6 percent from Fall 2004.
- About 86 percent of students were Georgia residents in Fall 2005.
- Students came from all Georgia counties, all 50 states, and 200 foreign countries in Fall 2005.
- In Fall 2005, 34 percent of undergraduates were over age 22.

Headcount enrollment represents a count of all students who are enrolled in credit courses at a University System institution, regardless of course load. Students enrolled at more than one institution are counted at each institution.

# FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT (FTE) ENROLLMENT

## Fall 1996- Fall 2005

FTE enrollment is the conversion of the number of students and hours students take into an equivalent number of full-time students. It is calculated for fall semester by counting each undergraduate full-time student (full-time is 12 or more hours) as one student and summing those numbers. All hours taken for part-time undergraduates are divided by 12 and added to the sum of full-time students. Each graduate and professional full-time student (full-time is 9 or more hours) is counted as one student, and the sum of students is calculated. All hours for part-time graduate and professional students are summed and divided by 9. The two sums are added together to get graduate/professional FTE. The undergraduate and graduate/professional totals are summed to get FTE.

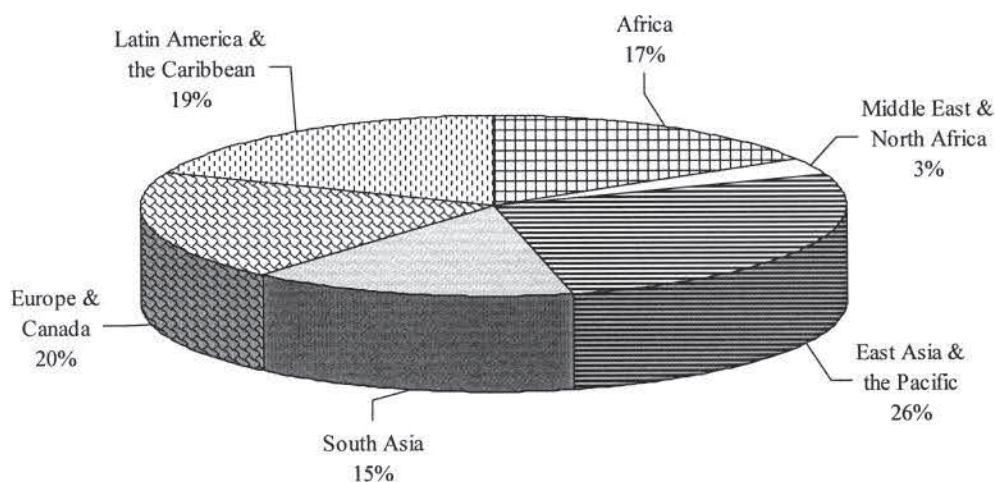

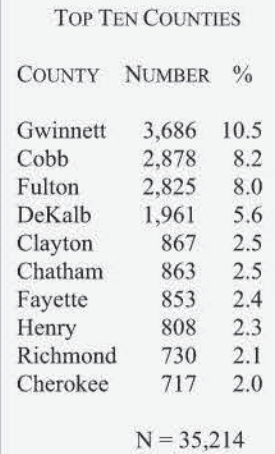

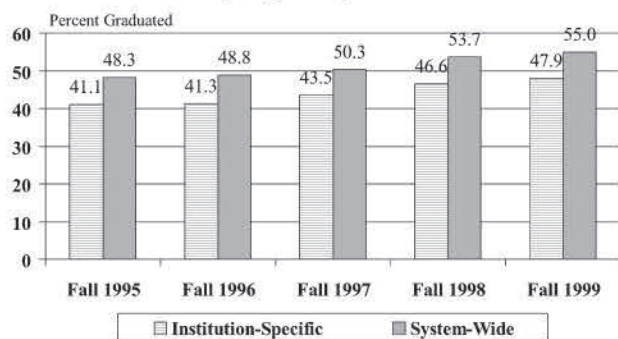

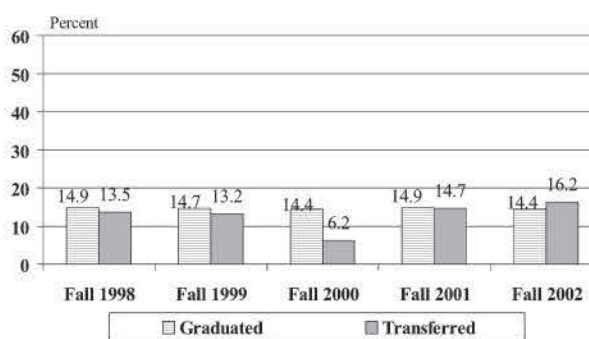
