

# Students

The System enrolled 233,098 students in Fall 2002, and it had an FTE enrollment to 183,753.

In Fall 2002, 66 percent of students were white, 23 percent black, 2 percent Hispanic, 6 percent Asian and 3 percent all other. 58 percent were female.

36 percent of students attended part-time.

Business and education were the most popular majors in Fall 2002.

There were 34,721 first-time freshmen in Fall 2002, up 4 percent from Fall 2001.

About 93 percent of students were Georgia residents in Fall 2002.

Students came from all Georgia counties, all 50 states, and 181 foreign countries in Fall 2002.

In Fall 2002, 35 percent of undergraduates were over age 22.

FTE enrollment is the conversion of the number of hours students take into an equivalent number of full-time students. It is calculated for Fall semester by dividing the hours enrolled by undergraduates by 15 plus the hours enrolled by graduate/professional students divided by 12.

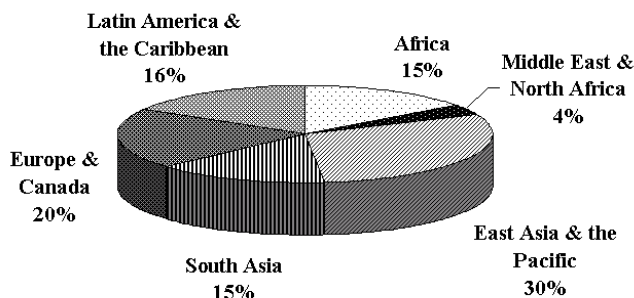

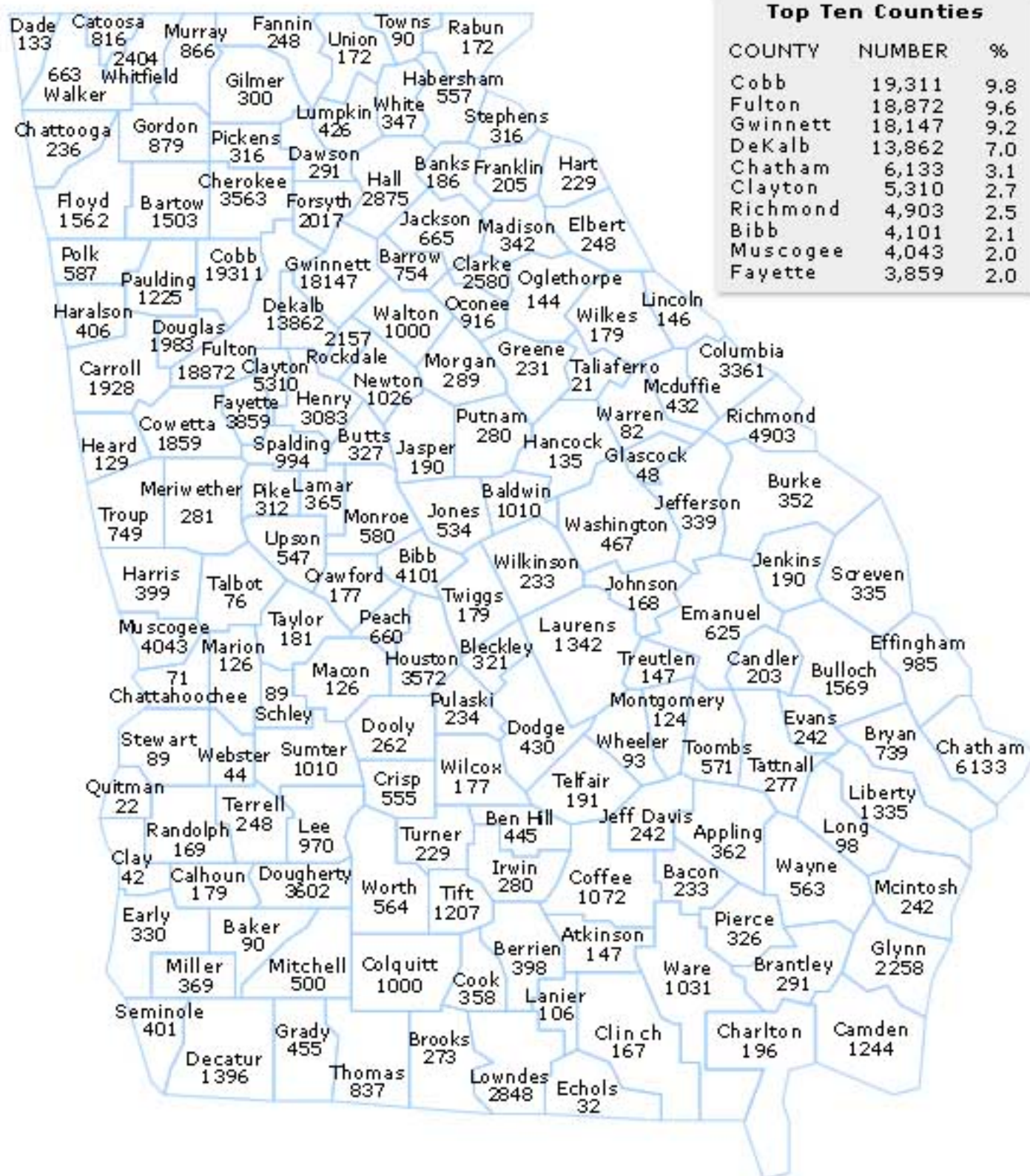

## All In-State Students: Fall 2002

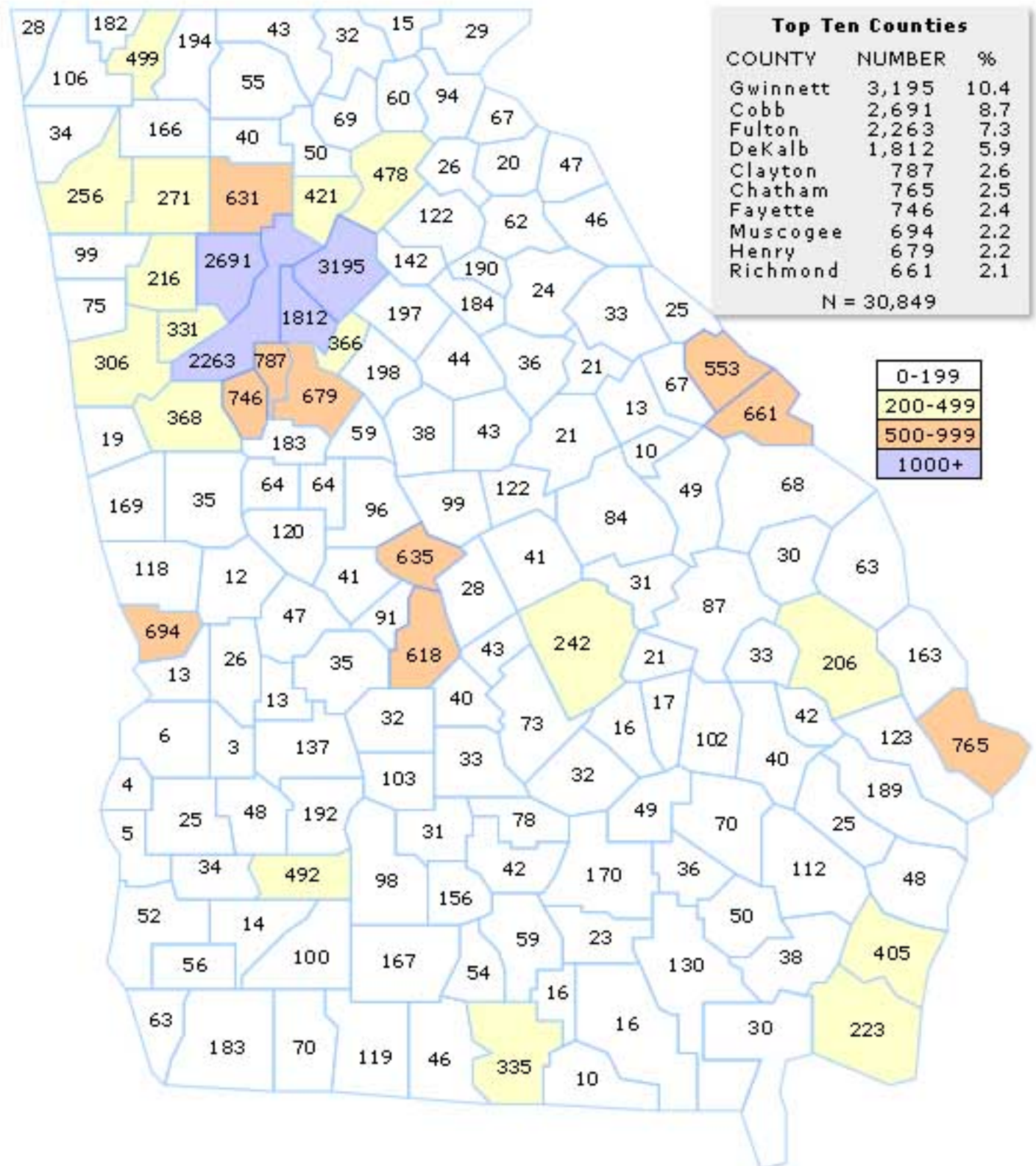

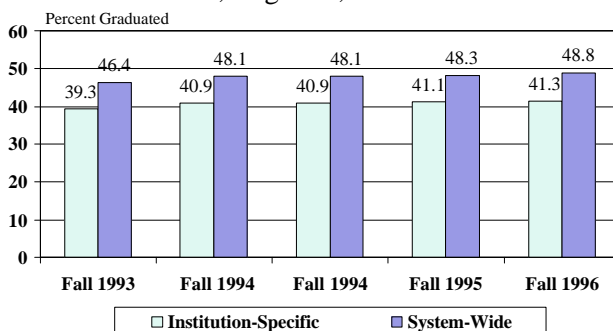

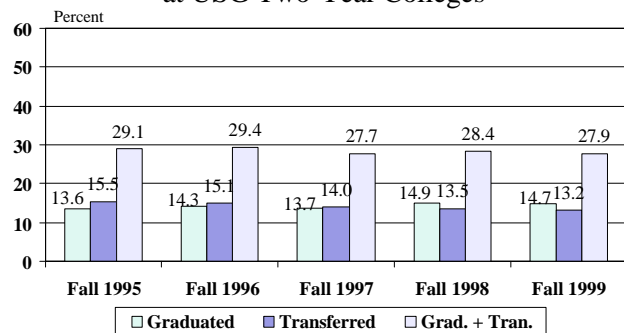
