



## University System of Georgia Costs of College Attendance in FY 2003

Colleges and universities report their cost of attendance annually to IPEDS. In addition to information on tuition and fees, for which there are University System of Georgia (USG) sources of data, the reported costs include books and supplies, room and board, and other expenses. The costs of room and board are reported for students living on campus, off campus, or off campus with relatives. Off-campus living costs are estimated by each institution. They vary by part of state and urban-rural differences, and may not be derived by a single, consistent method from institution to institution or across sectors. Costs are reported for both in-state and out-of-state students. The following are the major points based on data reported to IPEDS for FY 2003 by USG institutions.

- **In-State Students/On-Campus Total Costs.** USG in-state students living on campus pay an average of \$13,595 per year to attend a research university, an average of \$10,249 to attend a regional university, \$11,135 for a state university, and \$7,052 to attend a two-year college. Note that two state universities, both state colleges, and nine of the 13 two-year colleges do not have on-campus housing.
- **In-State Students/Off-Campus Total Costs.** For an in-state student to live off campus and attend a research university costs an average of \$14,621 per year, \$10,452 to attend a regional university, and \$12,579 at state universities. At USG two-year colleges, of which only four offer on-campus housing, the average total cost is \$10,136.
- **Out-of-State Students/On-Campus Total Costs.** For out-of-state students who live on campus, attending a University System institution is, on average, 59 percent more costly than it is for Georgia residents. For attending a research university, total costs to those students are \$22,965, or 69 percent more than in-state students pay. The corresponding numbers for regional universities are \$16,279 and 59 percent. State universities cost \$17,438 and two-year colleges \$11,045, both 57 percent more than the comparable in-state costs. The additional costs of living off campus are the same for both in-state and out-of-state students.
