

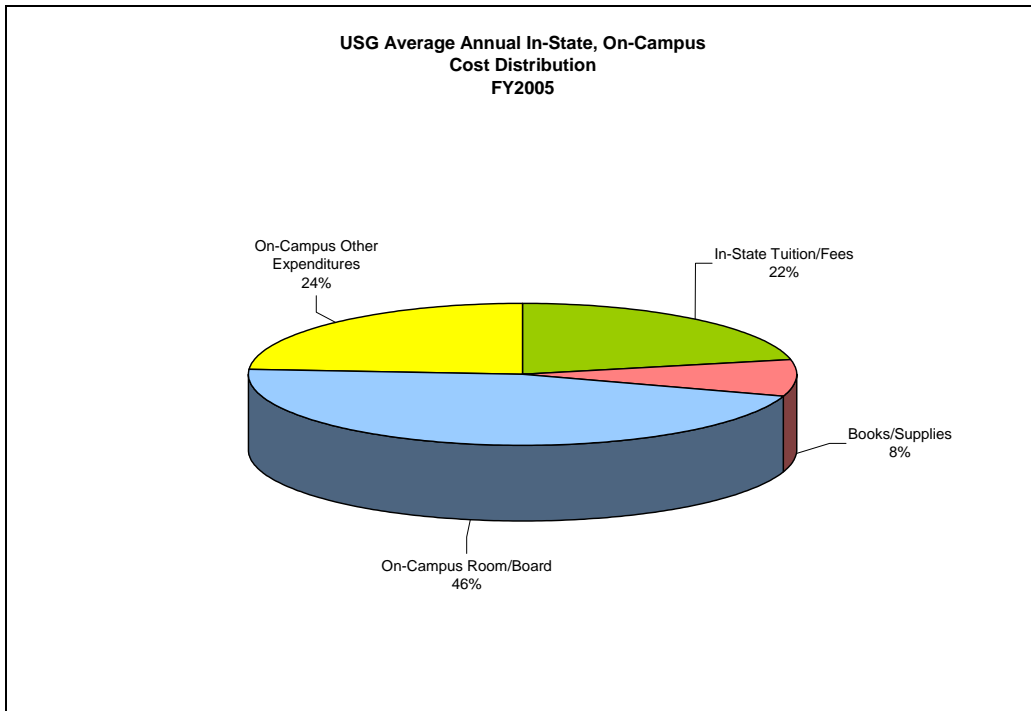


University System of Georgia Costs of College Attendance in FY2005

The National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) collects institution-specific data on the costs of college attendance. These data are used by higher education policy-makers for planning and management activities, as well as by students and parents in comparing college costs. This report examines FY2005 tuition and fees, books and supplies, room and board, and other expenses of both in-state and out-of-state University System of Georgia students. The costs of room and board are reported separately for students living on-campus and off-campus/living with relatives and not living with relatives. Off-campus living costs are estimated by each institution, and they vary by urban or rural location. Therefore, these costs may not be derived by a single, consistent method across institutions or sectors. The following are the major points based on the IPEDS data.

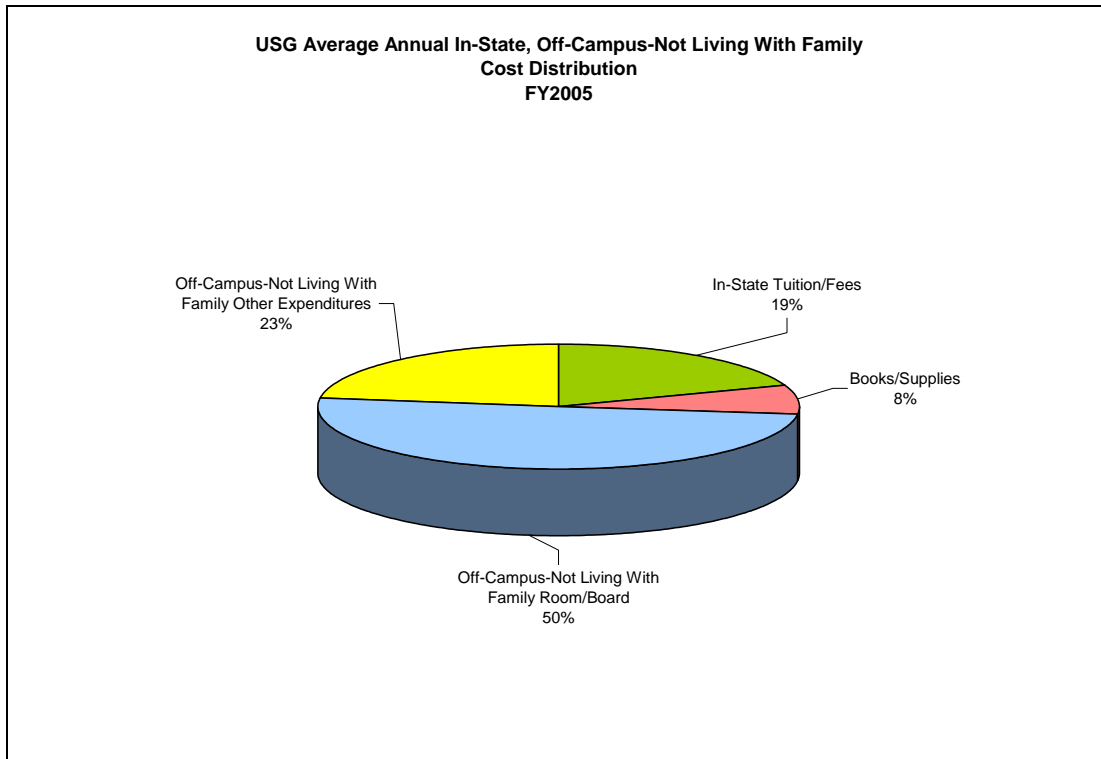
- Tuition and fees for out-of-state students attending a University System institution is, on average, three and one half times more costly than it is for Georgia residents. The University System average for in-state tuition and fees is \$2,484, as compared to \$8,779 for out-of-state charges.

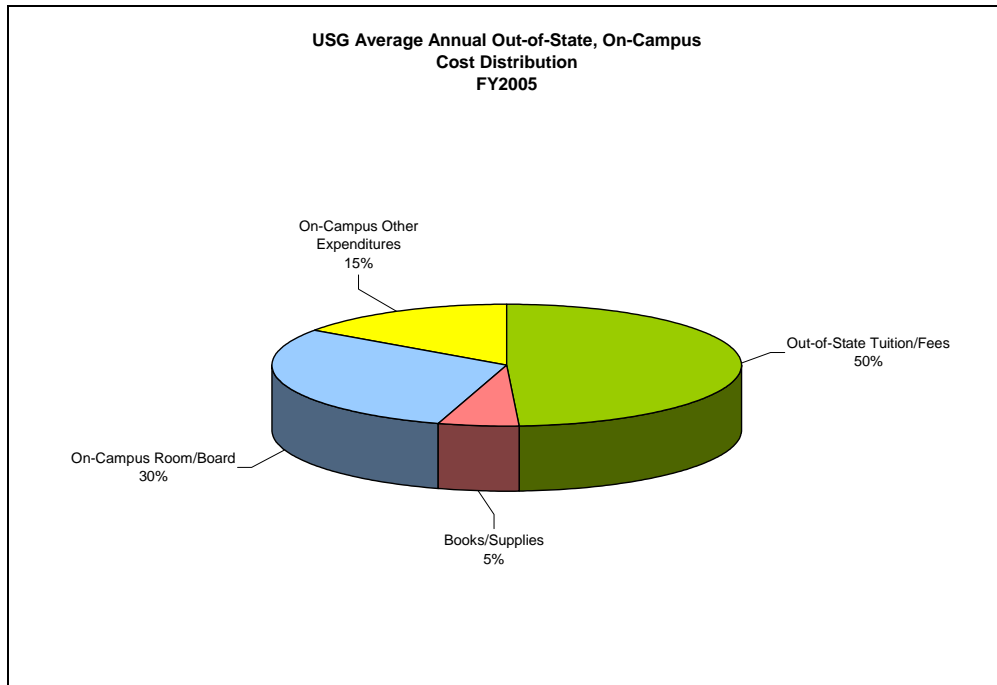
- USG in-state students living on-campus pay an average of \$15,006 per year in total costs to attend a research university. This represents an increase of \$746 from FY2004. Average total costs for regional universities amounted to \$12,823 (\$1,614 increase), \$12,186 (\$901 increase) for state universities, and \$8,540 (\$786 increase) for two-year colleges. It should be noted that two state universities, both state colleges, and nine of the 13 two-year colleges do not report having on-campus housing.

- The average total costs for an in-state student attending a research university and living off-campus on his or her own are \$15,506 per year (\$385 increase). It costs the same student \$12,766 (\$1,768 increase), on average, to attend a regional university, and \$14,392 (\$848 increase) to attend a state university. At USG two-year colleges, of which only four offer on-campus housing, the average total cost is \$11,121 (\$963 increase).

- For out-of-state students living on-campus and attending a research university, average total costs are \$25,574 (\$1,539 increase). The corresponding costs for regional universities are \$19,791, and \$19,374 for state universities. Two-year college attendance cost out-of-state, on-campus students \$12,944 in FY2005, \$1,319 more than FY2004.
