

Executive Summary

The purpose of this proposal is to create awareness from the Student Advisory Council with hopes to initiate action from the Board of Regents throughout the University System of Georgia. We hope this initiative will accelerate energy efficient projects and implement renewable energy technologies on each campus.

In this proposal, there are several outlined issues that we feel would make a significant difference of the progression of Georgia's renewable energy efforts. This proposal suggests the adoption and implementation of campus student sustainability fee's that would be implemented each semester from a governing body that would allocate this collected money. The fees would most cost-effectively meet campus and/or institutional energy demands while limiting global climate changing causing pollutants and the established governing body shall devote half (1/2) of each semester's allocated funds to the procurement and/or operation of institutionally owned renewable energy production facilities and equipment.
