### **SAC TO HOLD FALL CONFERENCE AT GORDON COLLEGE**

October 17, 2001 (Atlanta, GA) The Student Advisory Council to the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia (SAC) will hold it's Summer Conference this weekend, October 19-21, on the campus of the Gordon College in Barnesville, GA. Delegates from Georgia's 34 public colleges and universities will begin arriving in Athens on Thursday afternoon and meeting at the University of Georgia through Sunday afternoon.

Issues expected to be discussed during regular business meetings over the weekend include Textbook Sales Tax exemption (GA House Bill 67), USG Student Bill of Rights, and mandatory student fees.
