SAC to Hold Winter Conference Southern Polytechnic State University

January 8, 2002 (Atlanta, GA) The Student Advisory Council to the Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia (SAC) will hold it's Winter Conference this weekend, October 11-13, on the campus of the Southern Polytechnic State University in Marietta, GA. SGA President from Georgia's 34 public colleges and universities will begin arriving in Marietta on Friday afternoon and meeting at Southern Polytechnic State University through Sunday afternoon.

Issues to be discussed during regular business meetings over the weekend include Textbook Sales Tax exemption (GA House Bill 67), USG Student Bill of Rights, and mandatory student fees.
