



Active Known Issue: KI9.2-004-TL: Issue with Additional Straight Time

POSTED: December 19, 2018

STATUS: Known Issue

IMPACT: Additional Straight time (AST) calculation in a workweek that has Holiday and Vacation hours on the same day with total hours greater than 40. When the Time Admin process runs to create payable time, it identifies the Holiday and Vacation hours first, then regular hours.

Example: An institution has an employee that records a total of 41.7 during the workweek with the following Time Reported Codes (TRC):

- Reg = 18.7
- Vac = 7
- Hol = 16

The current TRC breakdown includes the 1.7 hours (greater than 40) in REG.

The correct TRC breakdown should reduce REG by the 1.7 hours over 40 as follows:

- Reg = 17
- Vac = 7
- Hol = 16
- AST = 1.7

Functional Workaround: This is an Oracle bug. The workaround is to correct the hours on the pay-line.
