Russell Palmer provided the following OpenAthens update:

- OpenAthens TLS Workaround
  - o GALILEO worked with OpenAthens and EBSCO to create a workaround so resources that no longer support TLS 1.0 access route through OpenAthens
  - Solved issues with linking/access to a handful of resources (eBook Central, Britannica...most recently, Westlaw) for institutions still on the GALILEO proxy
- Multiple Administrators
  - o Institutions may now add more than one administrator for OpenAthens administration

- o For example, UGA has now added an admin for e-resources and one for access services

  - \* The 2021 enhancements are a culmination of unfulfilled 2020 requests, items gleaned from the GALILEO annual survey, and reviewed by GDAC. Additional enhancement and operational updates are scheduled.
- RACL Feedback: Bento Release Strategy & Schedule
  - Bento release strategy
    - July—soft launch
    - Current "classic" search will remain default (Bento search will be available to use)
      - Less jarring for instruction and reference staff

- Time to create new reference and instruction content / tutorials
- Opportunity for GALILEO to get feedback from users and library staff
- Full release with additional improvements in December
- o Transition to Bento as primary search
  - Timing
  - After additional feedback integrated/search options are completed
  - Traditional EDS search will always be available

- Improve and standardize processes for patron loading
  - We've submitted a change request to USG to set up a weekly faculty/staff export from OneUSG Connect. We haven't heard back on this yet, but it can take several months to go through the USG change management processes.
  - As mentioned before, part of the initial plan is for institutions to download these exports and then manually push them into Alma via the Alma CSV User Loader Cloud App. One issue we ran into was that the user import template has to be set up manually for each institution. We brought this issue to Ex Libris, and they have developed a solution that allows for exporting and sharing the templates, which will simplify the setup process. This will go into production this summer.
  - There are other issues we need to iron out related to maintaining existing user data integrity when updating users via the Alma CSV User Load Cloud App. We're working with Rod at Augusta to test out solutions to these issues.

# RFI Suggestions

- Model on OhioLINK and MSU
- Use broad descriptions rather than specific functionality
- Ask respondents to address specific user stories / use cases
- o Provide full specs as reference, but focus on essential / day 1 functionality
- o Ask respondents to identify missing gaps rather than confirm every area
- Ask about collaboration and scaling
- Ask about architectural options and system requirements
- o No formal price quote, but baseline or standard rates for hosting and development

## • Next Steps: Need to Create

- o For each functional area:
  - Paragraph describing desired functionality (see MSU examples)
  - 2-4 (?) user stories that highlight desired functions
  - Ask respondent to review full specs and identify missing functionality (and when it will be available, if known)
- Also include examples of cross-institutional desired collaborative workflows (e.g., Shared cataloging? ILL outside of USG? Shared collection development?)
- o Architecture and infrastructure needs
- o Implementation, including general pricing

- Review information
