



## Area F Guidelines: Economics (non - B.B.A.)

Eighteen (18) hours of lower-division (1000- and 2000-level) courses related to economics or courses prerequisite to higher level economics or business courses:

<b>REQUIRED:</b>		
1.	Two, three-semester hour economics courses to include a course on <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ the Fundamentals of Microeconomics and a course on</li> <li>■ the Fundamentals of Macroeconomics, if not taken as part of Area E.</li> </ul>	(3 – 6 hours)
2.	Twelve to fifteen semester hours from the following electives: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>■ Fundamentals of Computer Applications</li> <li>■ Foreign Language (maximum of 6 semester hours)</li> <li>■ Statistics</li> <li>■ Calculus</li> <li>■ Other 1000 – 2000 level economics, sociology, history, or social science electives</li> </ul>	(12 – 15 hours)
<b>Total Semester Hours</b>		<b>18 hours</b>
