Academic Release 1.21

MODIFICATIONS:

Academic Release 1.21 includes the following:

- **Changes to the collection of ACT Composite Test Codes**
 - Campus ETL modification for the collection of the new A33 test code: ACT Test Score Composite – English, Math, and Reading
 - Updates to the Cognos Test Code Summary report to include a new column, TEST_COMPONENT_DESCR
 - Creation of validation rule VSTR263 to ensure the A33 test score is between 01 and 36
 - Modifications to data element STR009 to specify the ACT sections included in the A05 test code (ACT-Composite (English, Math, Reading, and Science)) and to data element STR001 to include A33 and the updated description of A05
- **Changes to the collection of Degree Level Codes and Student Level Codes for IPEDS reporting**
 - Creation of Degree Level Codes H, L, and R for specific graduate-level certificates and discontinuation of Degree Level Code F
 - Creation of validation rules VSPE024, VSPE025, and VSPE026 to ensure the correct Student Level is assigned based on the student's Degree Level Code
 - Modifications of validation rules VSPE002, VSPE003, VSPE004, VSTE228, VSTE229, VSTE230, VSTE237, VSTE238, VSGC015, VSGC019, VSGC028, and VSGR048 to include the updated valid values for Degree Level and Student Level codes

IMPACT: Implementation is mandatory.

PREREQUISITES: Data Collection ETL (ZADMETL) 1.3

TECHNICAL INSTRUCTIONS: CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL.zip

This zip file contains the Campus ETL script, which is required for all institutions and should be run as USGQUEST on the Banner database. It contains the tables, views, and selection criteria for the Academic Data Collection.

After downloading the zip file, you may run the following checksum command to validate that the file is the same as the one in the directory above.

1. Download the package (CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL.zip) file to a local server.
2. Run the following command to make sure the checksum info is the same as ITS posted with the package: `$ md5sum CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL.zip`
3. Verify the checksum info you get from the above command. It should be the same as below:
`523a6cacf773a87e7911480913560271 CAMPUS_ODS_ADM_ETL_INSTALL_1_21.zip`
4. Unzip the file.

BEST PRACTICE: You are strongly urged to apply this upgrade to your test environment before applying it to production. Institutions should comprehensively test using local business processes to ensure that the functionality meets regulatory requirements.
