#### **BACKGROUND**

- Sept. 2008 and Aug. 2009: BOR briefed on KSU Sports and Recreation Park, including possibility of football
- Dec. 2009: Football Exploratory Comm. named
- Sept. 2010: FEC recommends adding football
- Nov. 2010: Student referendum supports football
- Dec. 2010-Now: Fund-raising underway
- May-August 2012: Major asks made
- Sept. 2012: Major ask succeeds
- Oct. 2012: Student Fee Committee supports fee 10-1
- Jan. 2013: SGA reaffirms support for fee 24-1

- Helps student, faculty & staff recruitment
- Improves retention & graduation rates
- Adds to connections, networks & pride
- Assists in fund-raising
- Aids in branding





# THE PROPOSED FEE INCREASE FOR FOOTBALL AND TITLE IX

- \$100 increase in student athletic fee per semester beginning in Fall Semester 2013, from \$152 to \$252
- Will generate \$4.8-\$5.4 million per year
- Supported by 55.5% vote of students, with over 7,000 students (32% of student body) voting, in Nov. 2010
- Supported by 10-1 Student Fee Committee vote in Oct. 2012
- Reaffirmed by 24-1 SGA vote in Jan. 2013

FY14: Fully fund Women's Track & Field/Cross Country to 18 scholarships

FY14-16: Fully fund Women's Lacrosse to 12 scholarships

Acrobatics & Tumbling Crew Equestrian Sand Volleyball





# ELEMENTS OF INSTITUTIONAL FINANCIAL CONTROL

- KSU's President chairs Athletic Association Board
- KSU's Attorneys' Office provides legal review of all contracts over \$5,000
- KSU's Athletic Association Executive Committee (President, KSU CBO, AD, and Faculty Athletic Board Chair) approves all contracts over \$5,000
- KSU's CBO sits on Athletic Association Board and signs all contracts over \$10K



## IN-HAND SPONSORSHIPS AND GIFTS


- Major sponsor committed to sign MOU at \$5 million over 10 years
- Eight letters of intent for suite rentals at \$35K each, totaling \$280K in year one
- Two high probability verbal commitments for suite rentals at \$35K each, totaling \$70K in year one
  - Letter from KSU Foundation promising continuing support at \$200K per year

#### REDUCED EXPENSE PRO FORMA

FY14: No stadium improvements saves \$500K

FY15: No stadium improvements & reduced marching band support saves \$600K

FY16: Same reductions as FY 15 saves \$600K

FY17: No stadium improvements, reduced marching band support & no 5<sup>th</sup> year support saves \$700K

FY18: Same reductions as FY 17 saves \$700K
