SUBJECT: New Policy Information on Air Travel and Other Public Transportation

Effective October 1, while state travel regulations now allow First Class or Business Class airfare for international flights, including Alaska and Hawaii, the University System of Georgia (USG) **does not permit** First Class travel unless the circumstances noted in Section 4.6.1 of the Business Procedures Manual are met. While the USG aligns its travel procedures with those of the State of Georgia, in this case the USG has elected to be more restrictive with respect to First Class travel. The USG is committed to using its resources, regardless of fund source, in a fiscally prudent manner and believes First Class travel, except for permissible circumstances, does not demonstrate appropriate stewardship of institutional funds.
