SUBJECT: Accessing Georgia FIRST Financials after Release 5.40 (SSO)

## NOTE: This announcement replaces the previous announcement for this topic dated 11/02/18

University System of Georgia (USG) institutions currently using Georgia*FIRST* Financials will be required to use Single Sign-on (SSO) Authentication to access all PeopleSoft Financials services. This change will take effect 7 a.m. on Monday, December 3, 2018.

SSO is already required to log in and access other USG services (e.g., OneUSG Connect - Benefits) using their local credentials (i.e., ID and password) assigned by your institutions. Employees will use those same credentials to log in to Georgia*FIRST* Financials including Self-Service Travel and Expenses. When an employee is logged in to a service using SSO, they will be able to log in to other services using SSO without having to re-enter their credentials.

Access to Georgia*FIRST* Financials will be initiated from the Georgia*FIRST* Financials website. It is recommended that on Friday, November 30<sup>th</sup> you delete all existing Georgia*FIRST* Financials browser bookmarks or favorites and create a new bookmark/favorite for <u>https://www.usg.edu/gafirst-fin/</u>. A job aid is available to guide employees through how to log in.

All institutions are required to implement multifactor authentication (e.g., Duo) for securing information. Most institutions have completed implementation of a multifactor solution, while some are in progress. If your institution is currently using multifactor authentication for OneUSG Connect access, users will use it for Georgia*FIRST* as well.

  - Delete all existing browser bookmarks/favorites to the GeorgiaFIRST Financials URL.
  - Create a new bookmark/favorite to the Georgia*FIRST* Financials homepage <u>https://www.usg.edu/gafirst-fin/</u>.
