

ISSUE: The downloaded Excel file on any grid page is showing incorrect values for monetary amounts greater than 999.99. The first comma (digit separator) is displayed as a decimal point in Excel and the values after the first comma are displayed as three zeros. In the example below, the amount of 850,724.30 is downloaded as 850.000.

FUNCTIONAL WORKAROUND: There is no functional workaround for the grid functionality at this time. In some cases, there may be a BOR query that retrieves the

ESTIMATED RESOLUTION: Oracle is aware of the issue and is currently working on a fix. ITS will have the resolution in production as soon as possible.
