Known Issue Information	Resolved Known Issue: KI9.2-174_Other-Issue with "Notify" Button Functionality RESOLUTION: The issue with the "Notify" button was resolved through a fix that addressed the underlying Oracle bug. Users should now be able to access and use the "Notify" functionality across all affected pages without encountering errors. ORIGINAL KNOWN ISSUE: Following Release 6.00, an Oracle bug exists that affects the "Notify" button, which is present on many pages across the system. The button is not functioning on any of these pages and displays the message: "You are not authorized for this page."

Paid expense reports autosaving in FLUID changing accounting date

Navigation: Employee Self Service Homepage > Expense Report History Tile

Issue: ITS identified an issue where viewing an attachment from a paid expense report accessed via the Expense Report History tile on the Employee Self Service homepage caused the expense reports "Last Saved Date" and "Accounting Date" to update to the current date when the user clicked Done on the attachment pop-up.

Solution: Following the PTOOLS 6.08 release, this page will no longer autosave when users view attachments through this navigation path, preventing unintended date updates.
