

Calculating the HIGHEST EDUCATIONAL LEVEL CODE column in the HR Detail Report for Fall 2019

***Edited February 1, 2021 to update Job Aid link**

The HRDM Digest Report, HRDMX0103: INSTRUCTIONAL FACULTY BY HIGHEST DEGREE uses the HRDM data field Highest Education Level Code to determine the column contents.

In 2019, the OneUSG data source for this HRDM field was removed from the Personal Data information:





Since the Highest Education Level information is no longer maintained in OneUSG, USG needed to change the source of data used for the Digest Report categorizing Instructional Faculty by Highest Educational Degree.

The Digest Report's new source for this data comes from calculating the highest educational level from all of an employee's degrees listed in the employee education information in HRDM. The OneUSG source of this information is from the degrees entered into Person Profiles. The Job Aid information for entering degrees for an employee is at:

How the HIGHEST EDUCATION LEVEL CODE is calculated in the HR Cognos report:

After the change was made to no longer maintain the Highest Education Level field in OneUSG, a decision was made to pull the highest degree information from the HRDM Employee Education data and map that degree level to the existing HRDM codes for Highest Education Level. If there is no Employee Education information for an employee, the most recently recorded Highest Education Level data will be used.

Procedure:

1. Pull the Degree Level Code from the highest degree listed in an employee's degree information. Map this Degree Level Code to a Highest Education Level Code. *
2. If there is no Degree information (in OneUSG and therefore in HRDM) for an employee, the former (currently not maintained) Highest Education Level is used.
