The U.S. Department of Education's TEACH Grant Program provides grant funds to postsecondary students who are completing, or plan to complete, coursework that is needed to begin a career in teaching, and who agree to serve for at least four years as a full-time, highly qualified teacher in a high-need field, in a school serving low-income students.

Student Eligibility Requirements:

- •Undergraduate students must have a 3.25 GPA (high school GPA for first year undergrads) OR score in the 75th percentile on at least one admissions test.
- •GPA requirements do not apply to graduate students who are currently teachers or who are retiring and have expertise in a subject where there is shortage of teachers (math, science, special education, English as a second language, or another high-need subject).
- •Graduate students completing a high-quality alternative teacher certification program, like Teach for America, are also eligible for the program.
- •Students must be completing, or planning to complete, the coursework required to become a teacher.
- •To receive a TEACH Grant students must also agree to:
 - o Serve as a full-time teacher for at least four years within eight years of completing their course of study.
 - Comply with the requirements for being a highly qualified teacher (defined in section 9101 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act).
 - Teach math, science, a foreign language, bilingual education, special education, a reading specialist, or a subject designated as "high need" by the federal or state government, or local education agency and approved by the Department of Education.
 - Provide certification by the school's chief administrator annually as evidence of required employment.
