



AFY 2024 & FY 2025 Budget Instructions

- Provided by the Office of Planning and Budget (August 2nd)
- FY 2024 Amended Agencies were allowed to request one-time investment opportunities for initiatives that improve outcomes, customer service and how we do business
- FY 2025 USG permitted to request workload increases for growth in enrollment, increases in square footage, and health insurance changes through the funding formula
- FY 2025 USG B-Units and Special Funding Initiatives only allowed to request 3% enhancement funding requests and submit 1% budget reduction plans

Fall 2023 End-of-Term (cont'd)

- Updates to the ETL to alleviate these errors encountered:
 - VSGC023: USG Cumulative GPA must be greater than zero and cannot be null.
 - VSGC011: USG Cumulative Hours Attempted must be greater than zero and cannot be null.
 - VSTE135: HOPE Hours Attempted cannot be null if HOPE GPA is not null



Fall 2023 End-of-Term (cont'd)

- Updates to Cognos to fix known issues with these errors
 - VFCS005: Faculty Teaching Percentage must not exceed 100 for any individual instructor.
- Updates based on Banner changes (field size changes)
 - Source Background Information field change to 20 char.s will require update in FICE/HS application
 - Test Score Admin Type field change to 10 char.s. Only DED defined values (or their translation) will be extracted for Fall EOT.










Credit Hours Trend for Georgia State University
