**TO ADD THE SOPHOMORE-LEVEL COURSE IN CRIMINOLOGY TO AREA F RECOMMENDATIONS FOR THE SOCIOLOGY MAJOR**

**RATIONALE**

**THIS RECOMMENDATION WAS ACTUALLY APPROVED BY THE COMMITTEE IN 1996, AS EVIDENCED BY THE MINUTES OF THE COMMITTEE DATED NOVEMBER 6, 1997 ([HTTP://WWW.USG.EDU/ADMIN/COMM/SOCIOLOGY/MIN11.97.HTML](http://www.usg.edu/admin/comm/sociology/min11.97.html)). THE ORIGINAL PROPOSAL TO THE BOARD OF REGENTS APPARENTLY WAS LOST, SINCE TO DATE CRIMINOLOGY HAS NOT BEEN ADDED TO THE AREA F RECOMMENDATIONS. **THE ORIGINAL RATIONALE FOR ADDING CRIMINOLOGY TO THE AREA F RECOMMENDATIONS WAS THAT CRIMINOLOGY IS A SUB-DISCIPLINE OF SOCIOLOGY AND IS A SOCIOLOGY-BASED COURSE. THIS COURSE, THEREFORE, IS ACTUALLY A SOCIOLOGY COURSE EVEN THOUGH IT MAY BE LISTED USING THE CRJU DESIGNATION.**
