Host Campus SAC Conference Responsibilities

- Maintain constant contact with the SAC advisor (graduate assistant in the USG office) regarding logistics of the SAC Conference.
 - o Assist with reserving on-campus meeting space for the entire conference.
 - o Assist with contacting local hotels for room block rates.
 - o Assist with ordering food for the entire conference, including snacks.
 - o Assist with logistics needs for speakers.
 - Serve as the liaison between the University System Office and any third party contracted for services (i.e. food and lodging).
- Maintain constant contact with the SAC advisor (graduate assistant in the USG office) with this particular SAC Conference planning.
 - o Participate in conference planning teleconference calls.
 - o Assist in creating/providing feedback for conference agenda.
 - Assist in determining the appropriate conference fee.
- Attend the SAC Conference and assist in implementation of the agenda.
 - o Present topics at the conference as necessary.
 - o Facilitate break-out sessions as necessary.
 - o Run icebreakers/team builders as necessary.

Please note it is the SGA President's responsibility to host/run the SAC Conference once the Conference begins. It is also strongly preferred to have the President at the institution address the SAC students when on the campus.
