## THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF GEORGIA COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES

Thank you for your interest in the University System of Georgia (USG)! With 26 colleges and universities across the state, the USG provides students a wide range of options for continuing their education. This resource is designed to help future students identify the colleges and universities that best fit their interests and academic credentials. ## SCHOOL ACCREDITATION

The USG recognizes accreditation from the following accrediting bodies:

Applicants who attend a homeschool or high school not accredited by one of the above must document their RHSC units through the submission of a curriculum packet. The curriculum packet must include the course title, course description, learning materials utilized (textbooks, software, reading lists, etc.), year course was completed, course credits and grade earned, and the school, institution, or program through which the course was taken (homeschool program, private/public school, online program, postsecondary institution, etc.) for each RHSC unit completed. Institutions may require additional documentation and/or test scores to further assess subject matter competency and preparation for college-level coursework. Students attending non-accredited homeschools or high schools are encouraged to contact their institution of interest to learn more.

## REQUIRED HIGH SCHOOL CURRICULUM

Freshman applicants must complete the 17 academic units of the USG's Required High School Curriculum (RHSC). The courses that satisfy the RHSC are provided on the USG's Staying on Course document.

## HIGH SCHOOL GRADE POINT AVERAGE

A minimum High School Grade Point Average (GPA) is required and is based on the 17 RHSC units. High school numerical grades are converted to letter grades based on the conversion table provided by each high school and then converted to quality points as follows.

$$
\mathrm{A}=4 \quad \mathrm{~B}=3 \quad \mathrm{C}=2 \quad \mathrm{D}=1 \quad \mathrm{~F}=\mathrm{o}
$$

The GPA is calculated by dividing the total quality points by the number of high school units.

## SAT/ACT SCORE REQUIREMENTS

The USG is continuing to waive SAT/ACT score requirements through Summer 2025 at 23 of the 26 institutions. The temporary waiver does not apply to the Georgia Institute of Technology, the University of Georgia, or Georgia College \& State University (effective Fall 2024). The institutions to which the waiver applies may admit students
not meeting minimum test score and Freshman Index requirements but meeting a higher high school GPA requirement. This document provides the requirements to be admitted both with and without test scores.

## FRESHMAN INDEX

The Freshman Index (FI) is calculated using an applicant's High School GPA (calculated on the USG's RHSC units) and SAT or ACT scores.

SAT FI Formula: $\quad 500 \times(H S ~ G P A)+1.06 \times(S A T ~ E R W+M a t h)-74$
Example: A student with a 2.9 HS GPA and 480 SAT Evidence-based Reading \& Writing/440 SAT Math would use the following FI calculation:

& \text { SAT FI }=500 \times(2.9)+1.06 \times(480+440)-74 \\
& \text { SAT FI }=2351.2
\end{aligned}
$$

ACT FI Formula: $\quad 500 \times($ HS GPA $)+($ ACT Composite $\times 42)+88$
Example: A student with a 2.7 HS GPA and 18 ACT Composite would use the following FI calculation:

& \mathrm{ACT} \mathrm{FI}=500 \times(2.7)+(18 \times 42)+88 \\
& \text { ACT FI }=2194
\end{aligned}
$$

## LEARNING SUPPORT PLACEMENT

Learning Support is a generic term for programs designed to assist students with collegiate work and are intended to serve students who need additional support in mathematics or English (reading/writing). The "default placement" for all students is in entry-level English and mathematics with corequisite Learning Support unless exemption criteria are met.
